Instructions: Thank you for considering OpenSourceSDN (OSSDN) as a place to host your project. We have a lightweight application process, more to make sure that you have the resources to support the project in its infancy (by “resources”, we mean code authors, committers, and passionate contributors to get this project off the ground. OSSDN does not have a team of software developers to devote to your project, so we are looking for some sign of commitment on your part to sustain the project for the first 4-6 months until others join in. Most open source projects fail (let that sink in). The reason they fail is because the project has no commercial interest or application, or there is no committed cadre of people willing to devote their time to the success of the project. We’re trying to help you think through this project before we host it, so that we can maximize your chances for success.
